POULTRY MEETING SCHEDULED TUESDAY

N. L. Bennion, extension specialist in Poultry Husbandry, and Dr. E. M. Dickinson, associate veterinarian of the Oregon Experiment Station at Corvallis, will attend a meeting of turkey and chicken producers to be held in the Farm Bureau hall at Columbia park Tuesday, April 8, at 8 p. m., it was announced today by M. E. Knickerbocker, assistant county agent.

Dr. Dickinson who is one of the outstanding pathologists of the north-west, will discuss disease problems of poultry with particular emphasis on those diseases commonly encountered in the artificial brooding of chicks and poults. He will also be available to answer any questions growers may have on disease problems.
