1940 CENSUS SHOWS HERMISTON SLOW IN BIRTH REGISTRATION

According to a recent birth registration test, part of the 1940 Federal census of Umatilla county had an unusually percentage of unregistered births. The population areas in and surrounding Hermiston, Echo and Pilot Rock were particularly behind in the registration of births, and it is estimated that there are still several hundred individuals whose births have not been recorded living in and near these towns.

In the present day and age there are innumerable demands for birth records, and the State Health Department advises that every child should be recorded in the proper place. Birth certificates may be needed soon by children entering school. Later on in life the need for certificates are many.

In the event that any person wishes to ascertain whether or not their child's birth is recorded, all they need do is inquire by letter or card at the State Board of Health, Portland, Oregon, giving the child's name and date of birth, as well as the parents' name. In case the record has not been filed, notification will be made and forms will be supplied in order that the birth record may be made permanent in the files of the State Board of Health.

U. OF O. SCHEDULES SUMMER SESSIONS

University of Oregon—Six weeks of summer school, in the heart of the Willamette valley where extra-curricular vacations may be interspersed with hours of study, is being offered by the University of Oregon thirty-seventh annual summer sessions beginning June 16 and continuing until July 26.
