**BEE SUGAR QUOTA RAISED 116,425 TONS**  
Sugar beet growing areas of the United States may market 116,425 more tons of sugar than they had been previously allotted due to recent action of the U. S. Department of Agriculture, Walter A. Holt, Secretary of the county AAA committee, said today.  
The Department recently announced a substantial increase in the amount of sugar to be made available this year for the nation's consumers. The new figure is 7,627,563 tons compared with the previous figure of 7,125,561 tons, an increase of 502,002 tons.  
The 116,425-ton increase allotted the beet growing areas raises the areas' current 1941 marketing quota to 1,768,996 tons. This compares with a 1940 quota of 1,549,898 tons.  
Figures of the Sugar Division of the AAA show that growers have received parity or near parity income on their beet crops ever since the sugar program was started in 1934, and figures for 1940 are expected to show an income above parity, Holt said.  
Although all of the 1940 crop, largest in history, is not yet marketed, it is estimated that United States beet growers will show an average return of \$7 per ton. This compares with \$6.70 on the 1939 crops, and an average of \$5.52 per ton on crops raised during 1931-33, the last three production years prior to passage of quota legislation.  
Total supplies of sugar available to the U. S. this year are more than enough to take care of all normal consumption needs.
