AGENTS HELP WITH HOME DEFENSE
Oregon's corps of home demonstration agents with other home economics extension workers are already playing a large part in the home defense program, reports Mrs. Azalea Sager, state leader of this division of extension work. In the 14 counties with home demonstration agents, four major projects are being conducted.
"One of the first lines of home defense is that every man, woman and child have a sound, healthy body," says Mrs. Sager. "Since the basis for healthy bodies is an adequate diet, the home demonstration agent, through the training of volunteer leaders and other means, is giving out the latest information on nutrition. Demonstrations of adequate diets at low costs are being conducted and families are being aided in budgeting both food purchasing and home produced food supplies."
Even after all the discussion on nutrition in papers and magazines many homemakers are asking questions about the various terms commonly used, says Mrs. Sager. One woman said recently, "I am all confused—are vitamins in calories, or are calories in vitamins, or are they both the same?"
Another phase in home defense which the home demonstration agent is helping in is aiding rural families to utilize to the best advantage that which they already have in the way of home equipment and facilities. Simple home repairs, kitchen improvement, and clothing construction and tailoring are only a few of the items in this project.
