Umatilla county farmers are urged to attend the A. A. A. community elections during the week of December 8th through 12th, 1941.
Community committees and delegates to the county convention will be chosen at the community election meetings. The meeting in Hermiston will be December 12, at 9:30 a. m. in the Legion hall.
Following the community elections the delegates of the county convention will meet in the basement of the county office at Pendleton, Saturday, December 13th to review the business of the association during the past year and to elect county committeemen for 1942.
