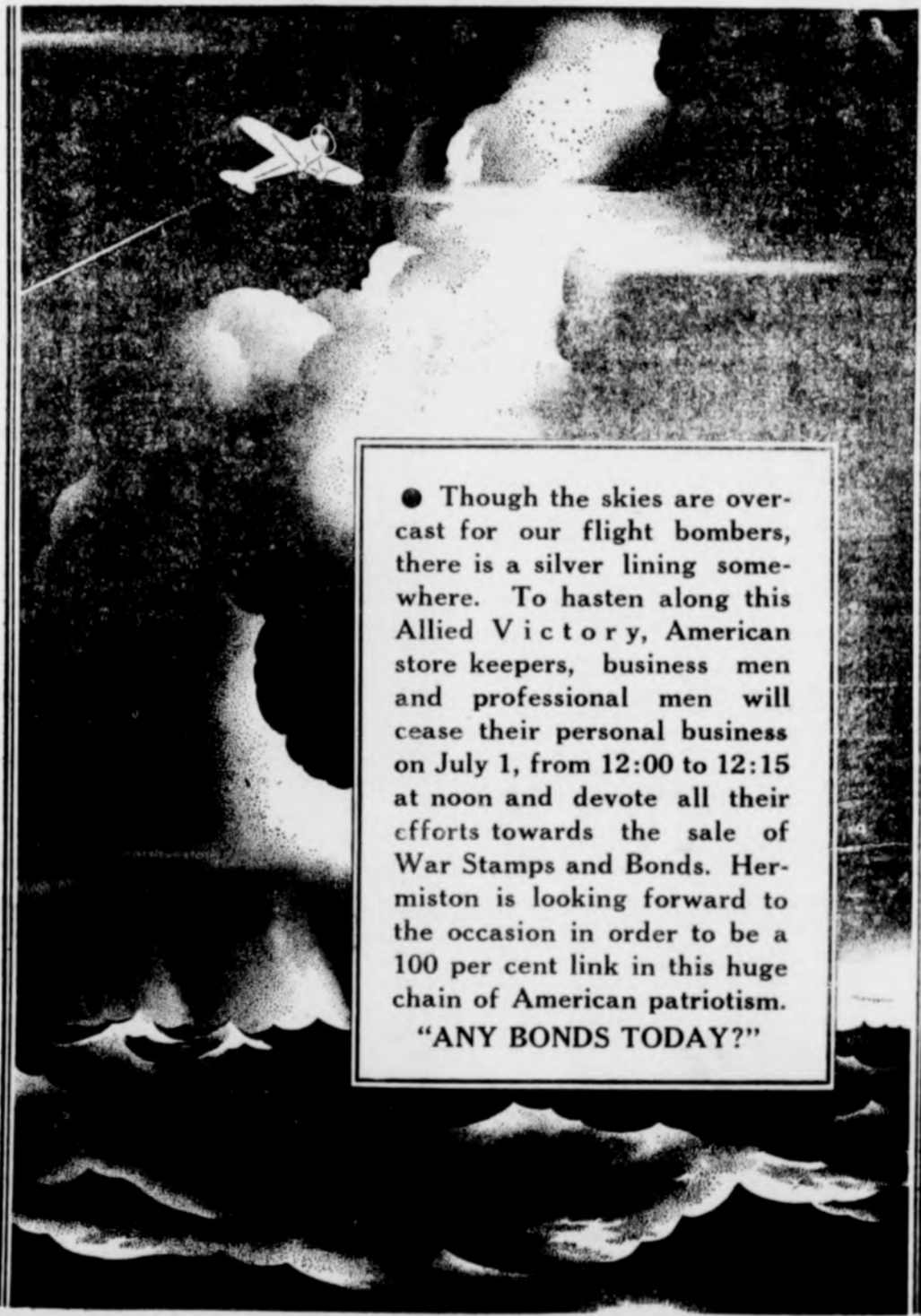
Help Win the War
