**DATES SET FOR TRUCK SIGNUP BY FARMERS**

October 22, 23 and 24 are the dates set for all farm truck and pickup operators to register for their certificate of war necessity. This certificate will entitle the bearer to purchase repairs and to get repair service on farm trucks and pickups.

The place of registration for all West Umatilla county farm truck and pickup operators will be at the USO building in Hermiston. A member of the county transportation committee and the AAA committee will be present to assist in filling out the application forms.

If a pickup or truck owner has not received his application form from the Detroit office, he should write for it. The address to write to is the Office of Defense Transportation, Central Mailing Office, P. O. Box 2259, Detroit, Michigan. In writing for the application, it is necessary to send the Detroit office all the information on the registration certificate for each truck and pickup that the farmer owns.

Farmers coming in to register with the farm transportation committee should bring information with them necessary in filling out the application and other necessary forms. This includes the registration certificates, speedometer mileage, miles traveled the past year, tonnage hauled, trips made in 1941, approximately mileage each tire has gone, his acreage of crops, numbers of livestock and poultry on farm and the approximate number of gallons of gasoline used in a year.
