Delight your family with these recipes for home-baked rolls

War times have revived interest in good plain cooking, and homemakers are beginning to do more of their own baking. There is nothing like the fragrant aroma of fresh homemade bread or rolls baking in the oven to quicken already heavy fall appetites. And really, making your own rolls is easy, especially if you use the recipe for REFRIGERATOR ROLLS given here.

These rolls have a decided advantage over most yeast breads, because the dough can be made several days in advance, then shaped and baked as you wish. Simply cover the dough, in one mass, and store in the refrigerator. About 1 hour before you want to serve rolls, take the dough from the refrigerator; let rise about 30 minutes; knead and shape into rolls; and bake another 30 minutes. That's all there is to it.

REFRIGERATOR ROLLS

7 cups all-purpose flour
2 cups milk
4 tablespoons shortening
2 teaspoons salt
4 tablespoons sugar
1 cake fresh yeast

Sift flour and measure. Heat milk. Place sugar, shortening, and salt in large bowl; add hot milk; stir until shortening is melted; cool to lukewarm, about 15 minutes. Add crumbled yeast; mix well. Add flour; stir until dough is light and double in bulk, about 2 hours. Punch down. Place on lightly floured board; knead until dough is smooth. Mold into desired shape. Place on greased baking pan. Cover with damp cloth. Let rise in warm place until double in bulk, about 30 minutes. Brush with glaze mixture of 1 part sugar and 2 parts milk. Bake in moderately hot oven (425 degrees F.) 15 minutes, or until done. Make in moderately hot oven after first rising. Cover tightly and place in refrigerator.

You can shape rolls as you wish, making them doily or man-sized. Keep in mind, however, that they'll double in size during the baking pan. For soft rolls, place them almost touching each other in size without crowding. Buy U. S. War Stamps with the money you save at Safeway!
