THE TEETH OF THE NEW FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY LAW ARE SHARP!

"Not less than 10 days nor more than 45 days after receipt by him of the report or notice of accident which has resulted in bodily injury or death or in damage to property of any one person, the Secretary of State shall suspend the license of any person operating, and the registration certificates and registration plates of any person owning a motor vehicle in any manner involved in such accident, unless and until such owner or operator, or chauffeur, or both shall immediately furnish and thereafter maintain proof of financial responsibility in the future."
