**ONE-SIDED FEED FOR HOGS COSTLY**

Quite a few cases where infectious diseases of swine have been suspected have been found to be due to poorly balanced feeding, veterinarians of the state department of agriculture report as a result of a number of such calls answered recently.

Hog producers are cautioned against feeding mostly wheat, which is a one-sided ration and mostly protein. Vegetable protein alone is not sufficient in the hog ration, which should contain, besides the proteins, foods rich in vitamins, especially alfalfa meal or green alfalfa pasturage.

**RATIONING CALENDAR**

**RATION BOOK NO. 3**  
 Brown stamps for purchase of meats, fats, etc.  
 January 1—Expiration date of brown stamps L, M, N, P and Q. Q becomes valid on December 19.  
 January 29—Expiration date of brown stamps R, S, T and U. R series valid December 26, S on January 2, T on January 9, U on January 16. Each weekly series good for 16 points.

**RATION BOOK NO. 4**  
 Processed fruits and vegetables, jams and jellies.  
 December 20—Expiration date of green stamps A, B and C.  
 January 20—Expiration date of green stamps D, E and F.

**SUGAR**  
 January 15—Expiration date of stamp 29 in Book Four, good for five pounds.

**SHOES**  
 Stamp No. 18, Book One, and "Air-plane" stamp No. 1, Book Three, valid for one pair each for indefinite period.

**STOVES**  
 Purchase certificates available at local ration boards.

**WOOD, SAWDUST, COAL**  
 Fuel dealers deliver by priorities based on needs.

**FUEL OIL**  
 January 3—Expiration date of period 1 coupons in new fuel oil rations.  
 February 8—Expiration date of period 2 coupons which became valid November 30.

**GASOLINE**  
 January 21—Expiration date of No. 9 stamps in A book, each good for 3 gallons.  
 Value of gasoline coupons: A, B-1, C-1, 3 gallons; B-2, C-2, R and T, 5 gallons; D, 1.5 gallons; E, 1 gallon.

**TIRES**  
 Cars with C ration books must have tires inspected every 3 months; B books every 4 months; A books every 6 months. Commercial motor vehicles must have tire inspection every 6 months or every 5,000 miles, whichever comes first.
