ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Hermiston hereinafter referred to as the "Owner", will receive up to, but not later than 7:30 o'clock P. M., War Time of the 14th day of July, 1944, sealed bids for the award of a contract or contracts for sewer system improvements located in the City of Hermiston, County of Umatilla, State of Oregon. Such bids shall be received in the office of the City Recorder in the City of Hermiston in the said County and State, and shall be opened and publicly read aloud at the above stated time in the Reclamation Building, meeting place of the City Council.

Each bid must conform and be responsive to this invitation, the Information for Bidders, the Plans, Specifications, and all the other documents comprising the pertinent Contract Documents. Copies of the Contract Documents are now on file and open to public inspection in the offices of the City Recorder located at Hermiston, and of R. H. This deposit will be refunded if the set or sets of Contract Documents delivered are returned in good condition within ten days after the bid opening.

Each bid shall be made out on a bid form to be obtained at either of the said offices in which the Contract Documents are on file. Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check payable to the Owner, or a satisfactory bid bond in favor of the Owner executed by the Bidder as Principal and a satisfactory surety company as Surety, in an amount not less than five per cent of the maximum amount of the bid. The check or bid bond shall be given as a guarantee that the bidder shall execute the Contract if it is awarded to him in conformity with the Contract Documents and shall provide the surety bond or bonds as specified therein within five days after notification of the award of the Contract to the bidder.

The Owner reserves the privilege of rejecting any and all bids or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any bid or in the bidding. No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of 30 days after the date set for the opening of bids.
