NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received until the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.M. on the 2nd day of May, 1945, and immediately thereafter publicly opened by the Council of the City of Hermiston, Oregon, at the Council Chambers in said City, for Sewer Revenue Bonds of 1945 in the sum of Twenty-nine Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$29,500.00); said bonds being dated April 1, 1945, maturing serially in numerical order at the rate of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00) on April first in each of the years 1946 to 1952, inclusive, Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) on April first in each of the years 1953 to 1959, inclusive, and Twenty-five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) on April first in each of the years 1960 and 1961; provided, however, that all bonds which mature on and after April 1, 1951, shall be subject to call and redemption in inverse numerical order, on April 1, 1950, and on any semiannual interest paying date thereafter; said bonds bearing interest at the rate of not to exceed Three per cent (3%) per annum, payable semiannually, principal and interest payable at the office of the Treasurer of the City of Hermiston, Oregon.

**RATIONING CALENDAR**

**Processed Foods:** Book 4—Blue stamps C2 through G2 valid through April 28; Blue stamps H2 through M2 valid through June 2; Blue stamps N2 through S2 valid through June 30; Blue stamps T2 through X2 valid through July 31.

**Meat, Butter, Cheese:** Book—Red stamps T5 through X5 valid through April 28; Red stamps Y5 through D2 valid through June 2; Red stamps E2 through J2 valid through June 30; Red stamps K2 through P2 valid through July 31.

**Sugar:** Book 4—Sugar stamp 35 valid through June 2; New sugar stamp valid May 1.

**Shoes:** Loose stamps invalid. Book 3: Airplane stamps 1-2-3 now valid.

**Gasoline:** Coupons not valid unless endorsed. "A" 15 coupons, 4 gallons each, valid through June 21. "B" 6-7 valid, 5 gal. each. "C" 6-7 valid, 5 gal. each.

**Fuel Oil:** Period 1-5 (incl.) coupons valid through August 31. Not more than 86 per cent of season's rations should have been used to date.

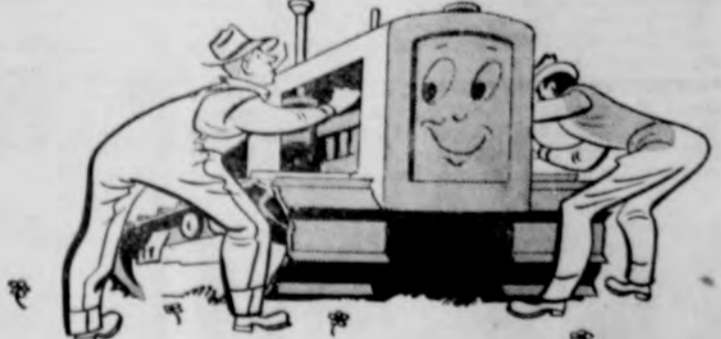
