Homebuilders association offering students scholarships

The Northeast Oregon Home Builders Association is offering several \$1,500 scholarships to help educate and train individuals in a profession related to the building industry. The scholarship recipient will be selected on the basis of his/her potential to succeed.

School Exclusion Day is Feb. 18

The Oregon Immunization Program is reminding parents that children will not be able to attend school or child care starting Feb. 18 — School Exclusion Day — if their records on file show missing immunizations.

State law requires that all children in public and private schools, preschools, Head Start and certified child care facilities have up-to-date documentation on their immunizations or have an exemption.

Parents need to know about this updated vaccine requirement:

• The hepatitis A vaccine, which protects against a communicable viral infection, is a two-dose series required for children 18 months and older in child care, preschool and kindergarten through sixth grade.

If school and child care vaccination records are not up-to-date, the child will be sent home.

Parents seeking immunizations for their children should contact their health care provider or local health department, or call 211Info — just dial 211. No one can be turned away from a local health department because of the inability to pay for required vaccines.

Pharmacists can immunize children 11 and older. Parents should contact their neighborhood pharmacy for details.

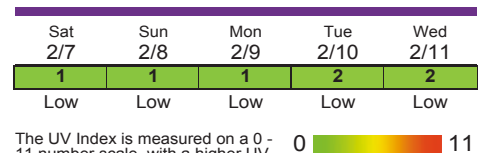
