
Pet of the week

- Drawn or sketched logo entries need to be dark and in color on white paper or card stock, not cardboard or canvas.
- The back of each entry must include the following information: full name,

date, the fair theme, grade, teacher and school name.

 Artwork must be submitted on paper no smaller than 8.5 by 11 inches but not larger than 11 by 17 inches.


