

General Farm Laborers/Irrigators wanted June 22, 2015 to November 1, 2015 for Peri & Sons Farms, Inc in Yerington, Nevada. There are 59 temporary positions available. Work duties will include, but not be limited to, preparing fields for irrigation by sprinkler or drip delivery system, performing scheduled irrigation of the fields, operating a tractor, as is the norm in growing diversified commodities, and assisting in land preparation and planting/cultivation activities.
