respect the burn ban, he said, and should never use illegal fireworks.

"It's shaping up, not only locally but all over the state, for what could potentially be a severe fire season," he said. "We're already starting to pick up some grass fires.'

Stanton said summer is also the busiest season for the ambulance services the district provides.

"For us, the busier we get with our ambulance

services, the harder it is to keep people at the station to fight fires," he said. "Our manpower resources are decreased, so we're stretched pretty thin. It can be very challenging at times to meet the demands of those multiple calls."

People who live near areas where grass fires are a possibility can help reduce the risk of a home fire, however. Stanton said people should create a defensible space around the house with green grass. He said pine needles should be swept off of roofs, and debris should be cleared from

The district also has mutual aid agreements with other fire agencies to help provide additional resources when necessary, Stanton said.

"We can't handle everything on our own, and they need help from us sometimes too," he said. "Nobody has enough resources to handle everything on their own. All fire departments struggle during the summer time, but we continue to strive to do our very best with what we have."







