STATEMENT OF CHANGES IN ACTIVITIES AND SOURCES OF FINANCING
The 2015-16 budget is \$4.8 million more than the 2014-15 budget primarily because the EOTEC Authority is expecting to expend the entire remaining money from the State \$6.4 million grant to finish construction of the Facility. In addition the General Fund will transfer a little more than \$3 million cash on hand to the Facility Fund. This results in a "double-counting" of these funds when looking at the facility budget as a whole. The 2014-15 budget includes a single FTE for the Facility Events Manager for four (4) months of the year and an additional FTE to assist with operation for three (3) months in the 2015-16 budget.
