The cookies were hand delivered on June 10 to Irma DeAnda, a foster home certifier and licenser with the Department of Human Service's Child Welfare Program. DeAnda's job includes finding foster homes for kids and providing training for foster parents.

DeAnda gave the girls a tour of her department and provided information about how the foster care program works. She explained that the program teaches the children's birth parents the skills they need in order to try to reunite them with their children and provide a better future for both the child and the parent.

The program serves 80 to 120 children from infants to teens in Umatilla County

at any given time. DeAnda said more foster homes are needed. Classes will be held this fall and will be listed in Blue Mountain Community College's fall catalog. The Child Welfare Program also needs children's socks, underwear and diapers.
