We have three main areas of operation.

- Our Warming Station which provides emergency overnight shelter during the winter months,
- A Day Center which provides a warm place to stay during winter mornings and a cool place to stay during the hottest afternoons of the summer, and
- Veda's Breakfast, which provides a free, hot breakfast every Sunday morning all year long.

We cooperate with local businesses to offer laundry and shower vouchers, provide personal hygiene items and clothing when available. Our personnel help with job searches and in finding support services appropriate to the need.
