COURT REPORT

Sentences

The following sentences have been imposed in Umatilla County courts:

FELONY

•Bradley John Bettencourt, 27, Hermiston, pleaded guilty to Tampering With Witness; sentenced to 18 months Oregon Dept. of Corrections, 2 years post-prison supervision and \$140 fine, plus court costs and fees; pleaded guilty to Resisting Arrest; sentenced to 6 months jail and \$40 fine, plus court costs and fees; pleaded guilty to Physical Harassment; sentenced to \$40 fine plus court assessment; pleaded guilty to Criminal Mischief II; sentenced to 6 months jail and \$40 fine, plus court costs and fees; pleaded guilty to Attempted Assault IV-domestic violence; sentenced to 6 months jail and \$40 fine, plus court costs and fees; pleaded no contest to a second count of Attempted Assault IV-domestic violence; sentenced to \$40 fine plus court assessment.
