Sentences

The following sentences have been imposed in Umatilla County courts:

FELONY

•Joshua Michael Mendenhall, 36, Stanfield, pleaded guilty to Possession of Methamphetamine; sentenced to 18 months probation, 90 sanction units, 30 maximum jail units, 80 hours community service, \$500 fine, \$2,000 fine-suspended and 6 months driver's license suspension.
