

**COURT REPORT**

**Sentences**

The following sentences have been imposed in Umatilla County courts:

**FELONY**

•Ricardo Salvador Alvarez, 34, Hermiston, pleaded guilty to felony DUII; sentenced to 15 months Oregon Dept. of Corrections, 2 years post-prison supervision, \$2,000 fine and permanent driver's license suspension, plus court costs and fees; pleaded guilty to Reckless Driving and Recklessly Endangering Another; sentenced to 90 days jail-suspended and \$100 fine; pleaded guilty to three counts of Driving While Suspended; sentenced to \$100 fine for each count, plus court costs and fees.
