which resulted in a whopping 26 free throw attempts in the second half alone for Kamiakin, who was successful on 17 of those attempts.

"I felt like most the second half we were just watching them shoot free throws," Arstein said. "We were sending them to the line too much, being too aggressive with our hands. We bailed them out a lot in the second half and we have to get better at picking our spots and playing smarter defense with our feet instead of our hands."

Kamiakin (1-0) took it's first lead of the game at 42-39 with 4:45 left in the game, but it didn't last long.

On Hermiston's next possession, Cesar Ortiz drilled a 3-pointer from the left wing to tie the game back at 42-all with 4 minutes to play.

However, Kamiakin took the lead back a short time later and didn't relinquish it.

Garrett Paxton was a big part of Kamiakin's second-half surge, scoring 16 of his game-high 18 points in the latter half of the game.

For Hermiston, Andrew James led the team in scoring with 13 points, while Chance Flores and Jordan Ramirez each scored 11 points.

Eight of Flores' points came within the first three minutes of the game

## Bulldogs defeat Chiawana on Friday

Chance Flores sank a short lay-in with just nine seconds left on the clock to give his Hermiston Bulldogs a 60-59 victory on the road against Chiawana on Friday night in Pasco, Washington.

Flores' basket also marked the first time in the game that the Bulldogs (5-0) held a lead.

"It was a pretty sloppy game on our end, a lot of things to work on," Hermiston coach Casey Arstein said, "but we'll take a win on the road any day."

Flores scored 20 points in the game, though none were bigger than his final two points. With Hermiston down 59-58 with 16 seconds left, the Bulldog defense forced a turnover and started a fastbreak down the floor. Flores caught the ball on the wing

and drove toward the basket from the baseline and sneaked a shot in.

Also giving standout performances for Hermiston was Xavier Rambo, who played in his first game back from a concussion and scored nine points, and Hunter Walls with eight points. Walls was 2-2 from the 3-point line, 2-2 from the free throw line, and provided solid defense while playing a lot of minutes for Hermiston.

"(Hunter) started and gave his best all-around game of the year tonight," Arstein said.

STANFIELD 78, GRANT UNION, 60 — On Thursday, the Stanfield Tigers kicked off the Columbia River Clash in Umattilla with a 78-60 win over Grant Union at Clara Brownell Middle School. The Tigers (2-1) pressure defense stonewalled Grant

Union for most of the afternoon, forcing 28 Prospector turnovers and limiting them to 48 shot attempts, while the Tigers put up 82 themselves.

The action was pretty back-and-forth for the entirety of the first quarter before Stanfield grabbed some momentum and ended the quarter with a 16-12 lead.
