Bob managed the Raleigh Hills, Oak Grove and then the Rockwood store. He was then promoted to toy and household sundry buyer. This position sent him to

Asia many times to search for and buy products. Several times he was able to have Lillie travel with him to Asia, which she really enjoyed.

In 1981, Bob left Fred Meyer to purchase a toy store in Mall 205. They owned and operated the successful toy business until retiring in 1985. Bob and Lillie spent the next five years full time RVing before settling in Boardman in 1991 to enjoy a slower pace of life. He enjoyed fishing in the Columbia River and was an accomplished gardener with a beautiful yard.

He is survived by his daughter, Sharon; sons Roland and Robert Jr.; a brother, Gary; six grandchildren; and several great-grandchildren, nieces and nephews.

Bob was preceded in death by his wife, his parents and two brothers, Kenneth and George Jr.
