SENTENCES

PENDLETON — The following sentences have been imposed in Umatilla County courts:

FELONY

*Taylor Gordon Morris, 26, Hermiston, pleaded guilty to Failure to Appear I: sentenced to 2 years probation, 120 sanction units, 60 maximum jail units, 120 hours community service, \$200 fine and \$1,800 fine-suspended, plus attorney fees.

*Oscar Paul Osuna Lopez, 31, address unknown, was convicted of Delivery of Methamphetamine: sentenced to 58 months Oregon Dept. of Corrections, 3 years post-prison supervision, \$200 fine and \$1,275 attorney fees-waived; was convicted of Possession of Methamphetamine and four counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Minor: sentences to discharge.
