During the summer months, club members gather each Friday night at Les Schwab Tire Center, 830 N. First St., Hermiston. People are invited to hang out, meet other car enthusiasts and learn more about the club.

Center, 100 Tatone St. There is no fee to participate. Participants should bring their own sewing machine and lunch.

The meetings include quilt construction, quilting updates, quilt education, a bit of history and friendship. In addition to working on individual projects, there are occasional presentations by regional quilt artists, field trips and quilting retreats.

Tickets for the raffle quilt are \$1 each or a half yard (18) tickets for \$5. To make arrangements to buy tickets, call 541-571-7009. Also, people can buy tickets during the Oct. 7 Sage Center Harvest Festival in Boardman, and during the Oct. 13-14 quilt show at the Boardman Senior Center.

Money raised from the raffle is used to pay for rental at the senior center, to bring guest instructors to meetings and to deliver or ship quilts for community service projects.
