Jabudah retired in 1984 after her husband Donald passed away on Dec. 29, 1983. Jabudah's greatest pleasure was traveling with Don all over the United States and abroad.

On June 25, 1988, Jabudah was united in marriage to Alan Grossmiller. Jabudah and Alan embarked on many wonderful travels including moving to Baker City and then returning to Hermiston in 2002.

Jabudah enjoyed photography, sewing, paint-

ing and drawing, writing poetry, cake decorating, gardening, traveling, music and all her wonderful grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

An Irrigon woman's wedding party was eclipsed after someone stole 100 pairs of solar glasses out of her vehicle Wednesday evening.

The Morrow County Sheriff's Department said several items were stolen from a car just before 6 p.m. on Southeast Thomas Street in Irrigon.

Patricia Martinez, whose vehicle was burglarized, said in

addition to the eclipse glasses the thief stole a travel carry case.

Martinez, who owns the Sub Zero Restaurant and Lounge in Irrigon, said she knows who stole the items out of her car.

The 100 pairs of glasses, Martinez said, were meant to be shared with Irrigon residents who wanted to watch the eclipse on Monday.

"It was going to be kind of a community event, just to try to do something together," Martinez said. "But it backfired on us.

We're unable to get more in time."

She said the window of the vehicle was slightly open, and that the suspect may have pushed down the window far enough to get the items out.

Martinez said she notified police of who she thought the suspect was, and said witnesses saw the person steal the items out of her car.

"I had witnesses state that (the suspect) was trying to sell my case at someone's residence," Martinez said.

"Unfortunately, the police didn't do anything."

Martinez also operates a motel near the restaurant, and said she has had trouble getting the police to follow up at her business. Martinez said there have been 10 to 12 incidents in the last four years that involve burglary or destruction of property at the hotel.

Morrow County Sheriff's Sgt. Sarah Smith said on Friday afternoon that the department did not yet have a suspect for the latest theft case.

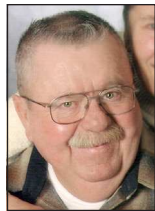

Ron returned to Tooele, Utah, and worked there until transferring to the Umatilla Army Depot in Hermiston, Oregon, where he worked until his retirement. He married Robin Evans in December of 1983.

Ron loved animals (especially raising sheep), fishing, camping, the ocean and cherished time with his family. Ron had a quick wit and always had a story to share.

His is survived by his
