General Farm Laborers/Irrigators wanted March 15 to November 1, 2018 for Peri & Sons Farms, Inc in Yerington, Nevada. There are 115 temporary positions available. Work duties will include, but not be limited to, preparing fields for irrigation by sprinkler or drip delivery system, performing scheduled irrigation of the fields, operating a tractor, as is the norm in growing diversified commodities, and assisting in land preparation and planting/cultivation activities.
