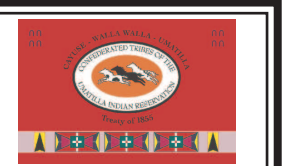

General Farm Laborers/Irrigators wanted November 10, 2018 to August 10, 2019 for Peri & Sons Farms of California, LLC in Firebaugh, CA. There are 4 temporary positions available. Work duties will include, but not be limited to, preparing fields for irrigation by sprinkler or drip delivery system, performing scheduled irrigation of the fields, operating a tractor, as is the norm in growing diversified commodities, and assisting in land preparation and planting/cultivation activities.
