# State police courtesy ride leads to couple's arrest

Oregon State Police Sgt. Seth Cooney's act of kindness led to the arrest of two suspects in recent

> Rushfeldt was the passenger in that car, Cooney said, but that was not a reason to arrest him.

Cooney dropped off Rushfeldt and planned to tell Lombardi, but soon heard from Lt. Keith Kennedy with the Umatilla Police Department. Cooney said Kennedy heard the state

asked if he arrested Rushfeldt.


Kennedy stated Rushfeldt was the driver that got away from Trooper Mitchell Goldman during a dangerous pursuit Monday night near Umatilla. 
