- 5. Yearlings must not have cut their two-year teeth.
- 6. Lambs must not have cut their yearling teeth.
- 7. Only one entry per breeder is allowed.
- 8. All sheep exhibited must be registered with appropriate breed registry. If animals do not have a breed registry then they must be shown in the Non-Registered category. Exception: Natural Colored Sheep.
- 9. Breed association certificates must be available for superintendent inspection. Breed association ear tags must be in place upon arrival at the Fair. Exception: Natural Colored Sheep.
