### **RULES**

1. Each exhibitor is limited to two fleeces per class.
2. Fleece must be shorn in current year and from animals.
3. Fleece must be tied with paper twine.
4. Fleece must be clean and properly skirted for competition.

### **DIVISION: WOOL & FLEECE**

#### **(Classes 01-07)**

**Class: 01** Five and a half-60's, 70's, 80's (*Merino, Tracheae, Rambouillet, etc.*)

**Class: 02** Three - eighths - 55's to 58's (*Columbia, Corriedale*)

**Class: 03** Quarter - 50's to 54's (*most meat breeds, Suffolk, Dorset, etc.*)

**Class: 04** Low Blood - 40's to 48's (*Romney, Coarse Crossbreeds, etc.*)

**Class: 05** Braid - 44's and coarser (*Lincoln, Cotswald, etc.*)

**Class: 06** Color - black, gray or brown, anything not white

**Class: 07** Other-Wool & Fleece

- **All animals received Thursday, Aug. 8, 7:00-10:00AM LATE ENTRIES NOT ACCEPTED**
- **SAME DAY ENTRIES MUST PAY FEES & FILL OUT AN ENTRY FORM AT THE FAIR OFFICE TO RECEIVE STALL CARD**
- All entry forms MUST be turned into the Fair Office. They will not be accepted in the barn.
- **The jackpot consists of the entry fees and matching sponsor money, after administrative expenses are deducted. Carcass Data will be Collected Upon Processing.**

## **DIVISION: JACKPOT LAMB CONTEST**

**Class 100: Resale-** (All lambs will be purchased and processed by Kalapooia Valley Grass Fed Processing LLC in Brownsville, OR.)

**All lambs will be transported for processing on Sunday**

### **RULES:**

1. Entry Fee: \$25 per head (REMIT TO UCF. PAY AT FAIR OFFICE)
2. Phase A: Live placing – 40% of jackpot & Phase B: Carcass placing – 60% of jackpot.
3. Entry limit – 2 lambs, either male or female, any breed or crossbreed.
4. Market lambs will be weighed & ear tagged after arrival.
5. Any lamb found to be a yearling in Phase A or B will be disqualified.
6. Cryptorchid and ram lambs will be disqualified.
7. All lambs entered in Phase A will compete in Phase B.
8. All lambs will be harvested by buyer.
9. Market lambs will be judged according to the board posted in the barn. Handlers will be provided and owners must remain outside of the show ring.
10. The carcass placing will be on an adjusted Yield Grade. Visit [www.umatillacountyfair.net](http://www.umatillacountyfair.net) for complete carcass judging criteria listed under "Exhibitors".
11. Jackpot winnings and buyer payment will be paid via check from Umatilla County after carcass data has been received.

**NOTE: Until the palatability and tenderness of Callipyge (heavy muscled) lamb is determined, they will not be accepted for the Jackpot Contest.**

Premium: Jackpot Award will be divided as follows:

- A. Live Placing – 40% of the jackpot
- B. Carcass Evaluation – 60% of jackpot

If 20 lambs or LESS are entered, the jackpot money will be divided amongst the top three lambs in each phase of the competition in the following amounts:

**1<sup>st</sup> place:50%**  
**2<sup>nd</sup> place:30%**  
**3<sup>rd</sup> place: 20%**

If OVER20 lambs or more are entered, the money will be divided amongst the top five lambs in each phase of competition in the following amounts:

**1<sup>st</sup> place:40%**  
**2<sup>nd</sup> place:30%**  
**3<sup>rd</sup> place:15%**  
**4<sup>th</sup> place:10%**  
**5<sup>th</sup> place:5%**
