RULES:

Tied, minimum 3 inch diameter at the butt; straw full length all forage (except corn and sunflower) to be cut in late bud to early bloom stage.

Corn for ensilage, 3 stalks, ears tied in bundle. Sunflowers left intact, entire stem and head brought in.
