Use of Fair theme, design, color, originality, quality of product. Use your own choice of container, base, backing, etc. No artificial or plastic flowers. In all classes, plant materials are to be predominantly fresh unless otherwise stated.

Must be created **in current fair year** (Aug.-Aug) and must not have been previously entered in the Umatilla County Fair. Accessories are optional in all of these classes.

DIVISION: YOUTH FLORAL ARRANGEMENT

(See "Adult Floral Arrangement" rules. Youth may use dried Washington. Entries must be produced by the exhibitor.

IF NOT PICKED UP WITHIN 48 HOURS OF THE CLOSE OF FAIR, ALL HAY KING ENTRIES BECOME PROPERTY OF THE UMATILLA COUNTY FAIR.

RULES

1. All hay exhibitors will compete by entering three (3) conventional rectangle (two or three tie) bales, one (1) large round bale or large rectangular bale. These bales will be visually judged and also core sampled of analysis.

All hay bales must be left for display during the duration of the fair. The contest is open to producers in Oregon and

2. Laboratory analysis will be provided by Ag Health Labs in Sunnyside, WA for 2019

3. Hay probe will be awarded to the Overall Alfalfa Hay King winner when over 15 alfalfa entries have been submitted.

4. The final placings will be based on the combined visual score and RFV analysis. Any entries containing noxious and/or fresh materials) weeds will be disqualified.

5. High combined scoring alfalfa hay will be named the Alfalfa Hay King.
