3. Exhibit halls will remain closed during judging on Monday.

4. In the event of a controversy, the Department

Superintendent will refer to the Overall Open Class Home-Ec Superintendent, Fair Manager or Fair Board Member for resolution.

5. The judge or Department Superintendent will have the right to reclassify and/or disqualify entries.

3. No string, tape or saw tooth hangers will be accepted. No glass larger than 16" x 20" shall be held by plastic clips. Glass must be property seamed. Weight limits will be considered for wall hanging entries, as

to ensure the safety of our Fair patrons and staffPaintings and associated frames or materials must be

completely dry before they will be accepted..
5. Work will be judged on *individual merit* taking into account the class of the artist, originality in artist concepts, skilled use of the medium, and overall presentation.

6. ABSOLUTELY NO EXHIBITORS PERMITTED IN BUILDING DURING JUDGING.

Limits: Exhibitors may enter <u>1entry per class</u> unless otherwise specified, with a <u>maximum of 5entries per</u> **Division**. Exhibits may not exceed 10 square feet measured without the frame, unless authorization is granted from the Superintendent prior to the submission date.
