COMMERICAL TRUCK CROPS

Exhibit must be from ¼ acre or more in size for each class entered and must be accompanied by current record book. NOTE: Lots in Section 2 are the same as Lot 1 through 42 in Section 1.

FRUITS

(Each flat to consist of 12 specimens)

Lot:

1. Apples, any variety, 12
2. Berries, any, one pint box
3. Cherries, any, with stems, one pint box
4. Grapes, table/juice, any variety, 1 quart box (minimum 2 cluster)
5. Grapes, wine, any variety, 1 quart box (minimum 2 clusters)
6. Prunes, dried, 1 quart plastic bag, previous crop
7. Fruits, any variety, 12

NUTS

(Each entry to be in a wide mouth quart jar) Lot:

1. Walnuts, 1 quart

SILAGE

Lot:

1. Corn, 1 quart in plastic bag
2. Legume, 1 quart in plastic bag
3. Any other variety

VEGETABLE SEED

Lot:

1. Any variety, 1 pint in wide mouth jar

HONEY AND BEES

Lot:

1. Comb honey, 2 sections enclosed in cellophane
2. Extracting frame honey, 1 frame
3. Bees, in glass display case
4. Extracted honey, 1 pint

SPECIALTY CROPS

Lot:

1. Mint oil, 3 oz. Minimum
2. Sugar beets, 3
3. Sugar beet seed, 1 pint, wide mouth
4. Any other variety
