When he graduated from high school he went on to study hypnotherapy, psychotherapy and neuro-linguistics programming. Today he claims to have about a 90 percent success rate of putting a subject under hypnosis.

"I literally am living my dream," Mabrey said. "I'm very passionate about it and I get to work with some awesome people like Tim Allen and Comedy Central.

Mabrey said he learned the power of humor when he lost a finger at the age of nine.

"I was told by a doctor, if you laugh about it, you'll feel better," Mabrey said. The humor element of his hypnotist performances is in the unexpected — what people do and say under hypnosis is anyone's guess.

"The funniest part is I never know what I'm going to get. I don't have a script and I don't know what I'm going to do when I come on stage. Every time I do a show I get a different result," Mabrey said.

Working with people all these years he said he can quickly figure out what motivates a person to go under hypnosis.

"I can tell a lot about a person by their shoes, their clothes or their hair — everyone gets an individual skit, which is what makes it super funny," Mabrey said. "I probably laugh harder than anyone else."
