"Often, kids hang out and practice their new skills long after the performance is over," Pearl said.

Beyond her scheduled appearances on stage at the fair, Pearl said she's taking her circus tricks and physical comedy to the Umatilla County Fair day camp.

"I think it's fantastic there's a camp right at the fair," Pearl said.

"The kids who go to camp can do workshops with me and come to the show during the week."

"Kids in the audience love it," Pearl said. "It's awe inspiring for them to see other kids perform."
