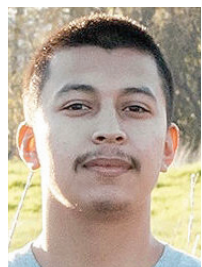

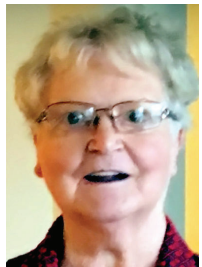
Viewing will be held on Friday, March 13, 2020, from 3-6 p.m. at Burns Mortuary chapel in Hermiston.
