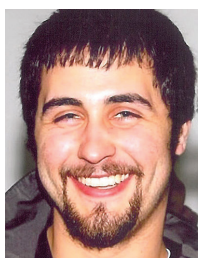
He is survived by his mother, Kathy Moore; father Dan and wife Candi
