

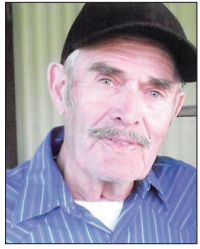
OBITUARIES

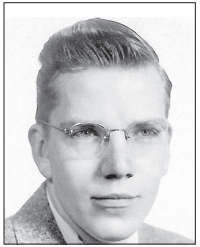
