Umatilla County law enforcement to crack down on intoxicated drivers

The Umatilla County Sheriff's

Office has announced that it will be increasing the number of deputies on patrol this holiday season in an effort to crack down on and discourage drunken drivers, according to a press release.

The effort is part of Oregon's DUII/High Visibility Enforcement grants program, which funds law enforcement to increase the number of officers on the street aggressively seeking out impaired drivers.

The department is asking for community assistance by requesting that the public call in and report suspected intoxicated drivers. The event will run from Dec. 16, 2020, through Jan. 2, 2021.
