the lunch will be used to make more Quilts of Valor or quilts to be donated to those who need them. Also during the ceremony, the winner of a quilt raffle will be drawn.

Quilts of Valor are made by volunteers who donate their time and materials. Typically the quilts are patriotic in theme and colors. Individuals as well as groups may contribute their hand-made quilts.


## **QUILTS = HEALING**


Quilts of Valor Foundation Catherine Roberts' son Nat was deployed in Iraq. According to Catherine:
