

# A weekend of fun in Sumpter

## Flea market, concerts, train rides

**S**UMPTER — With a flea market, train rides and an outdoor concert, Sumpter is serving up lots of activity for Labor Day weekend. Masks are required indoors and outdoors in large gatherings.

### FLEA MARKET

The traditional holiday weekend flea market runs from Friday through Monday, Sept. 3-6. Vendors will set up along the main street of town as well as at the fairgrounds.

### CONCERT

Special this year are two performances of In a Landscape: Classical Music in the Wild, featuring pianist Hunter Noack. He will set up his piano at the

Sumpter Dredge for outdoor concerts Friday and Saturday, Sept. 3 and 4, both at 5:30 p.m.

Tickets are free for Baker County residents, or \$30 for nonresidents. An extra add-on is a ride with Noack aboard the Sumpter Valley Railroad for \$25. The train leaves McEwen Depot at 4:30 p.m. both days. Reservations are required.

### TRAIN RIDES

The Sumpter Valley Railroad will take visitors on short runs Saturday and Sunday, Sept. 4 and 5, beginning and ending at the Sumpter Station.

"The short runs give everyone an opportunity to ride the train,

go to the flea market, grab a corn dog, visit the Trading Post and all the other fun events that weekend," said Kim Svaty of the SVRR.

The train departs Sumpter at 11 a.m., 12:30 p.m. and 2 p.m. Fares are \$18.50 adults, \$15 for seniors and military, \$10 for ages

3-17, and free for 2 and younger. Masks are required.
