## TAMASKLIKT RESUMES FEATURED EXHIBITS

MISSION — A mixed-media exhibition marks the return of featured exhibits at Tamástslíkt Cultural Institute. The first exhibit since 2019, "You Are Here" explores themes related to place and identity. Many of the featured artists draw from personal and collective histories and memories.

It opens on Free First Friday, with no admission charge — Friday, Feb. 4 — and runs through May 14. Tamástslíkt, located off Interstate 84 Exit 216, near Wildhorse Resort & Casino, is open Tuesday through Saturdays, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Masks and social distancing are required.
