CROSSROADS CARNEGIE ART CENTER

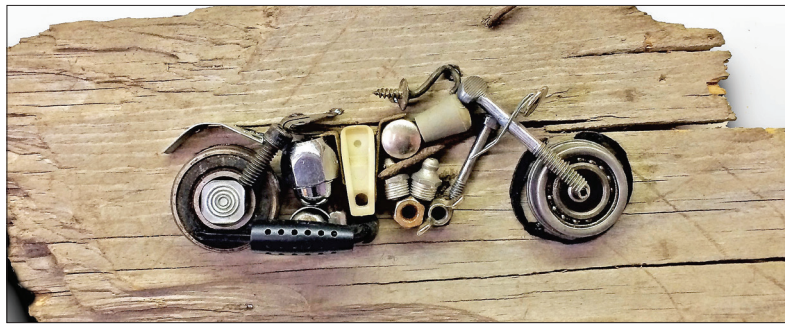
2020 Auburn Ave.

The SAQA exhibit, titled "Habitat," will display how each artist used fine art quilt abilities to create the featured works.

"From a 3-D honeycomb piece to breathtaking interpretations of riparian areas, this exhibit will sure show our visitors that the quilt is more than just fabric," said Alyson Spiering, community art director.
