The Writing Project facilitators are Nancy Knowles and Amelia Ettinger. To view past readings, visit artcentereast.org/events/ace-writing-project.

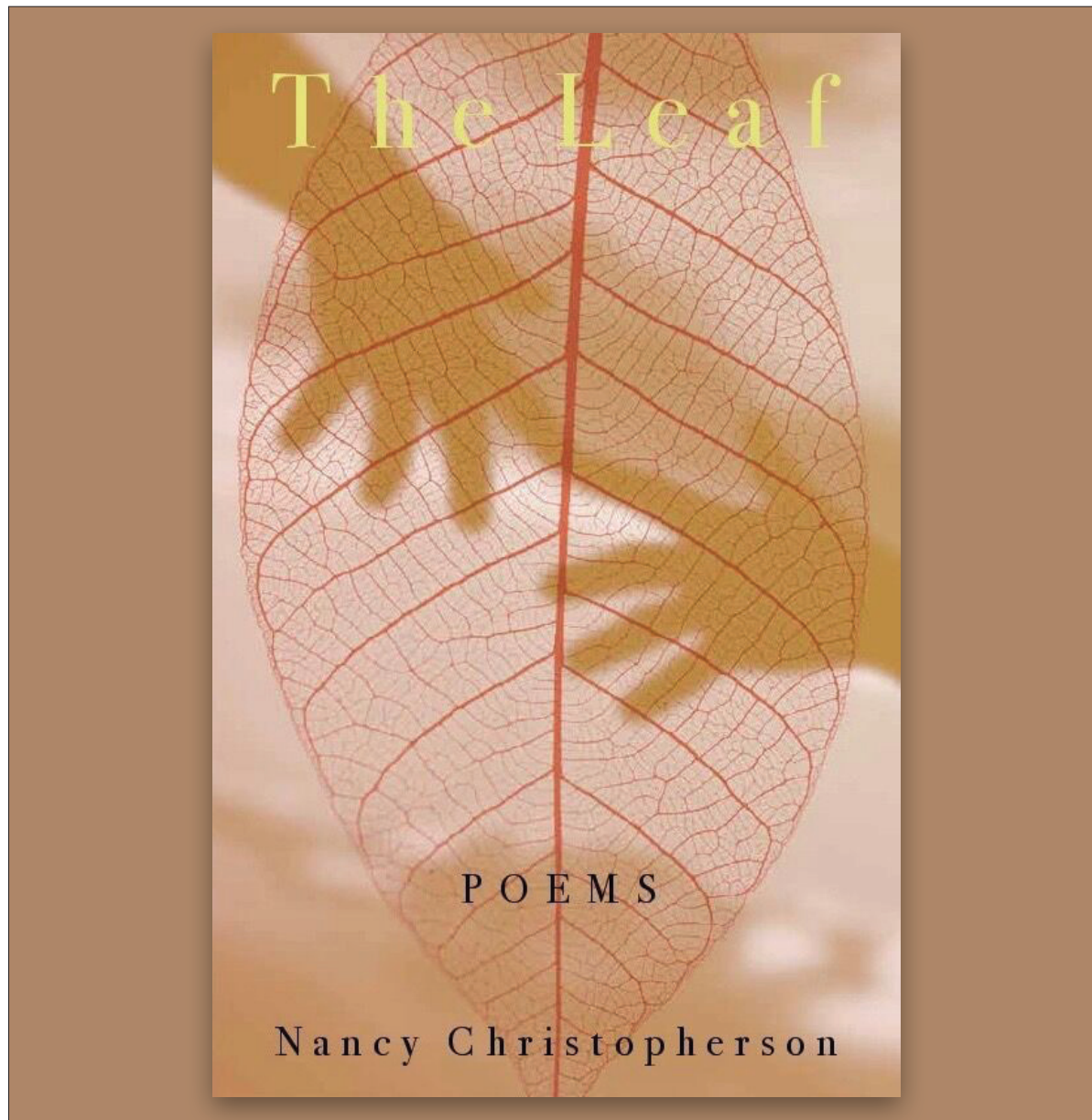
