

From Nashville to Baker City: Meet Laney Jones

BAKER CITY — Laney Jones grew up in theater, but these days she sings her own songs instead of reciting from scripts.

"I've loved music since a young age," said Jones, who grew up in Florida and now lives in Nashville, Tennessee.
