Boardman city water is safe

Local officials, workers explain the facts of Morrow's drinking water issues

Still in the midst of a local state of emergency, officials and experts are alerting the public about the safety of local drinking water in Morrow County.

The city of Boardman has, for example, notified people that city water is safe for drinking. It has posted this information on a sign

near city hall:

"The city's water is safe to drink," it states.

City Manager Karen Pettigrew supported the sign's message with a press release.

"Different than their rural neighbors, city of Boardman residents receive safe and dependable water supplied from local aquifers," the press release explains.
