## SANTA CLAUS COMING TO LEXINGTON

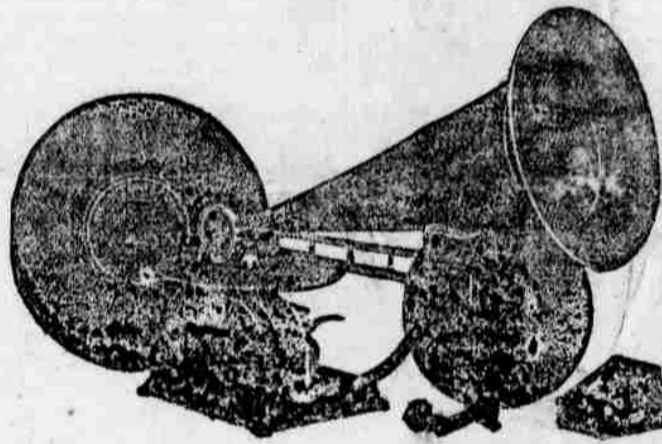
The Wheatfield has received the following message from Santa Claus.
